

The 17th International Coastal Symposium 2024 (ICS2024) Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Title of abstract: maximum 150 characters.
- Abstract word limit: 300 words.
- Abstracts must be written in English.
- An abstract must briefly introduce the research topic, outline the methods and main findings, provide an analysis of the results, and conclude with the study's significance and implications.
- The abstract should not include references.
- Authors should ensure that they have written and submit only entirely original works that have not been submitted elsewhere.
- An abstract can only be submitted once, duplicates will be removed.
- There is no limit to the number of abstracts that may be submitted by an individual.
- In order for a paper to be published as part of the ICS2024 Proceedings, at least one of the authors must be a registered delegate of the ICS2024. A registered individual of the ICS2024 may publish a maximum of two papers. After the two-paper limit, at least one of the additional co-authors of the accepted paper must also be a registered individual of the ICS2024.

Themes/ topics may be subject to change, the Scientific Committee may join themes and/ or re-allocate submissions however they think is most appropriate.

Authors have the option to select either an oral presentation or a poster presentation, however, the Scientific Committee reserves the right to make the final decision concerning the form of presentation.
